AS THE DISCIPLER, YOU WILL NEED (CPR):

CONNECTION: Your PRIMARY GOAL is to connect them to 1 John 4:7 2 Cor 5:18 God (to know him). Connect at a heart level to facilitate this. Be present, ask good questions, and listen. Victory is when you have John 10:30 Psalm 139:13-16 connected their heart to the word and to the presence of God. **COMPASSION:** Be motivated by compassion, not duty. By Matthew 9:36 Galatians 6:2 definition, compassion is deep awareness of a person's suffering Romans 12:15 accompanied by the desire to relieve it. Luke 15:20 **CONSISTENCY:** Walk steady with them for an assigned season. Galatians 6:9 Discipleship isn't a moment in time. It is a relational walk to Hebrews 13:8 connect them to God. This builds trust, which you will need! 1 Cor 15:58 **CELEBRATION:** Verbally affirm every step in the right direction. Proverbs 16:24 **CONFIDENTIALITY:** Keep all conversations confidential unless Proverbs 11:13 Proverbs 25:9 you get their permission. If someone is in danger, seek mentorship. Proverbs 17:19 **PERMISSION TO PROTECT:** Outside of your family, ask God 1 Peter 5:2-32 & the person for permission to cover, lead, and strengthen them. Proverbs 14:6 **POWER:** Rely completely on the Holy Spirit's dunamis power Acts 1:8; Eph 3:20 Romans 8:5 (efficiency, ability and might) inside of you! We aren't good enough on our own to lead someone into the fullness of Christ. 1 Cor 2:5; 4:20 **PRAYER & FASTING:** Pray and fast for them regularly. Psalm 35:13-14 **PATIENCE:** The growth process feels slow, like watching grass 1 Cor 13:4-8 2 Peter 3:9 grow, but suddenly it's overgrown! Model faith and patience. **RECEIVE THEM** into the family of God. They are no longer Romans 8:14-17 Ephesians 2:18-19 outsiders, but adopted sons and daughters, part of a family of God. **REGULAR MEETINGS:** Set a schedule to meet on a regular Hebrews 10:24-25 Matthew 18:20 basis, especially if your schedules don't naturally overlap. ROOM TO GROW: Just like a baby learning to walk, a disciple Romans 3:23 Luke 6:36 will stumble a few times. They may feel shame when this happens. Your mercy, coupled with a focus to get back up again, helps relieve 1 John 5:4 them of condemnation and shame. Jeremiah 29:11 Psalm 145:8

RESOURCES: Invest your time, energy, and money into them as

the Holy Spirit leads you.

THE DISCIPLE WILL NEED (CPR):

THE CROSS: Understanding what Jesus accomplished for us through his death and resurrection is PRIMARY to an unhindered connection to God. Teach this thoroughly. Explore the meaning of communion (the body and the blood.) Model communion regularly.

John 3:16 & 14:6; Romans 6:23; Psalm 103:2-4; Hebrews 4:15; 1 John 1:9; Eph 2:8

CONSECRATION: Model and teach a set-apart (holy) lifestyle.

COVER: They will need to be covered by a godly wise counsel of people for full development in Christ.

COMMUNITY: Help them discover and exercise their gifts inside a body of believers, building genuine bonds with them. Connect them to a local church and a Prayer HUB (www.hervoicemvmt. com).

1 Peter 3:8; 4:10; 1 Cor 12; Heb 10:24-25 Proverbs 15:22

CURRENCY: Faith is the currency of the Kingdom. Teach them to walk in faith, speaking words of faith, trusting God for the unseen. Help them believe, declare and stand on God's word.

POWER: Lead them to the baptism of the Holy Spirit! This will allow them to live in God's overcoming power, rather than self-effort.

PRAYER & FASTING: Maturity and freedom in Christ requires a daily prayer life with times of fasting. Help them establish this.

PRAISE: A heart and mouth full of praise and gratitude opens the door to emotional stability, blessing, and contentment.

Hebrews 13:15; Psalm 100:4; Isaiah 61:3

PRESENCE: Teach them to practice abiding in God's presence 24/7: awareness of his voice, his affection, his correction, etc.

John 10:27; 15:1-17; 1 Chron 16:11

PRINCIPLES OF THE KINGDOM: We are at war between the Kingdom of light and dark. Teach them to operate under Kingdom principles for their victory. (Generosity, Forgiveness, Sowing/Reaping, Fruits of Spirit, Faith, Power of Words, etc.)

RENEWAL OF THE MIND: To be totally free, they must read, meditate and declare the word of God. New thoughts = new life!

REPENTANCE AS A LIFESTYLE: This is simply turning from what we thought was right and submitting/walking in God's ways.

2 Cor 7:14; I John 1:9; Acts 3:19

REDIRECTION: Correction is a part of training. With time and love, you will have the authority to course correct as the Spirit leads.

REPEAT/REPLICATE: Their turn! Empower them to disciple others!
